Dear Parent/Guardian,

KidSport Alberta/Canada is a not for profit charitable organization that provides grants to kids, age 18 and under, so that they can participate in a season of sport.

KidSport Crowsnest Pass (www.KidSportCanada.ca/Alberta/Crowsnest-Pass) is the local chapter of KidSport Alberta. All funds raised through donations to KidSport Crowsnest Pass stay in Crowsnest Pass and support our kids.

Crowsnest Pass families who are facing financial barriers to participation in sport can apply online for grants of up to \$250 per kid per year. Applications are reviewed and approved by the local chapter.

Last year, KidSport Crowsnest Pass provided grants to 34 kids who participated in about a half a dozen different sports, for a total of \$5,892.

This year we have added the Pass Powderkeg Program that will provide a season pass, school program lessons and equipment if required to local kids who qualify for the grant. More information on this program is available at www.PassPowderkeg.com/KidSport .

What is KidSport?

KidSport is a charitable organization that provides grants to help cover the costs of registration fees so that all kids aged 18 and under can play a season of sport. Our chapter accepts applications and administers grants of up to \$250 per kid/year, for kids who live in Crowsnest Pass.

Is my child eligible for up to \$250/year towards sport?

Kids aged 18 and under are eligible to apply for a grant. KidSport considers the economic barriers facing the family when determining eligibility. KidSport uses the Government of Canada's low income cut-off (LICO) guidelines plus approximately 30% to determine eligibility. Families that are on low income, unemployed, on AISH or currently receiving income support through provincial government are all considered eligible. Proof of income for each adult in the home is required.

What does a KidSport grant cover?

Grants are allocated for sport registration fees. Equipment, travel to competitions or coaching is not eligible for funding. Eligible kids can access up to \$250/year (this can be used on more than 1 sport).

How do I apply?

1. Apply online or use the paper application form. Both can be found at: www.KidSportCanada.ca/Alberta/Crowsnest-Pass

Be sure to complete all sections of the application, as incomplete applications take much longer to process, and can cause delays in receiving your grant.

2. Proof of income for each adult in the home is required. Preferred document is your family's Canada Child Benefit Notice. Other options include: Proof of Income Statement from CRA, Tax Notice of Assessment, proof of need from provincial support programs (Income Support, Subsidized Housing, Child Health Benefit Letter).
3. Your completed application will be processed within 30 days of being received. If you qualify for KidSport funding, the grant funding will be sent directly to the sport program your child has signed up for.



Pass Powderkeg Program

We are pleased to announce a new partnership that will give all local youth the opportunity to ski. This program is designed to remove the financial barrier to skiing for families that otherwise could not afford to participate. Under this program, eligible local youth will receive a fully subsidized bundle including a Youth Season Pass, full participation in the local school ski programs (Grades 1-6) or an individual lesson (Grades 7-12) and a seasonal equipment rental if required.
